Sep 9-18, 2025

A unique trip covering the must see AND places not visited on other tours including places of the Oct 7 terror attack. Meet Israelis who evidenced it, PLUS enlightening encounters with Israeli law enforcement and BMS first responders.



Day 1, Sep 9. Tuesday. Transatlantic flights from NY or Chicago Dinner, breakfast and inflight entertainment on board.

Day 2, Sep 10. Wednesday. Airport meet and assist and transfer to **Jerusalem.** Check-in to hotel. Dinner and overnight rest.

Day 3, Sep 11, Thursday. Visit the new **National Memorial** site and the **Nation's Great Leaders Tombs.** Meet the **Border Police**, the toughest men and women of the Israeli Police. Dinner at our hotel. Optional night activity – the light and sound show at the Kind David Tower or new findings in the Wall Tunnel. Stroll at the dynamic Ben Yehuda Street.

Day 4, Sep 12, Friday. Early departure to the Judean Desert to visit the famous fortress of Masada. Enjoy a dip at the Dead Sea and return to Jerusalem to the Western (Wailing) Wall including a meaningful service. Kiddush and Erev Shabbat dinner.

Day 5, Sep 13, Saturday Great Synagogue service (optional). and. **Jewish Quarter walking tour.** (If Christians join the group – visit the Holy Sepulcher church and the Way of the Cross). Dinner at our Jerusalem hotel.

Day 6 Sep 14. Sunday Visit Yad Vashem holocaust museum. Proceed to Latroun - Armored Corps museum. Lay a wreath at the memorial wall. Visit the **new amazing WWII Jewish Soldier Museum** https://www.jwmww2.org/About_The_Museum. Arrive Kibbutz Lavi for dinner and overnight.

Day 7, Sep 15 Monday, Galilee. Tree planting in the Galilee hills. One tree will be plated on behalf of Shomrim, but you may plant individually in memory of someone and receive a certificate (\$50 each). Meet a Druze family and enjoy refreshments and sweets. Visit Misgav Am and Metula which were heavily damaged during the last war (subject to local clearance). Back to Kibbutz Lavi hotel. After dinner – listen to a kibbutz member about life in a kibbutz.

Day 8, Sep 16 Tuesday. Atlit Detainee Camp of illegal immigrants during British andate https://www.tripadvisor.com/Attraction_Review-g6000499-d5994320-Reviews-Atlit_Detainee_Camp-Atlit_Haifa_District.html. Arrive Tel Aviv for a Panoramic tour - Rabin's Square, Habima Square, Rothschild Blvd and the beach from which the Altalena ship was sunk. Also visit Anu - Museum of the Jewish People https://www.anumuseum.org.il/. Dinner at our Tel Aviv hotel.

Day 9, Sep 17 Wednesday. Gaza envelope. Visit the **Nova party memorial** to see where the horrific **attack of Oct 7**, 2023 took place as well as **Kibbutz Be'eri.** Meet with a kibbutz member who was there on that day. <u>Visit the site where the Sderot Police Station</u> <u>was attacked and place a wreath</u>. dinner at our hotel in Tel Aviv.

Day 10, Sep 18 Thursday. **Back home**. Airport transfer and flight home. Arrival on same day. Welcome home! You have just returned from a lifetime meaningful experience

GENERAL INFORMATION (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ): <u>THE PRICE INCLUDES:</u> Round trip flights from Chicago and NY • Four-star hotels • Meals: Daily buffet breakfast and dinner • All excursions detailed in the itinerary, with licensed guides and deluxe air-conditioned vehicles • Entrance fees to sites mentioned in program • Luggage handling in Israel (only 1 suitcase) • Group Transfers to/from airport in Israel • Even tips for guide, driver and hotel restaurants. Price is based on double occupancy and on a minimum group of 22 participants and minimum 12 flying together from each city.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE: **Personal expenses**, **soft drinks during meals**, **recommended travel insurance of \$184**. (Or \$115 but in case of cancellation it covers only \$3000). Single room supplement is an additional \$1010, mandatory for the participant that does not have a roommate. aviatours and your leader will try their best to find a roommate, but if we are unable to find one for you 60 days before departure, you will need to pay the single supplement or stay in a triple bedroom. (Third bed is a roller bed). **Passports and Visas:** Your passport must be valid at least until Mar 20, 2026 **(It is your responsibility to verify that your passport is valid for travel).** TSA Guidelines requires your passport to be valid at least 6 months after the return date. USA citizens do not need a visa to Israel. **BAGGAGE**: Only 1 piece of luggage of 50lb is allowed. The carry on should not exceed 12lbs. (2nd suitcase will cost \$200 in addition to overweight)

<u>Cancellations and insurance:</u> Between 180 – 100 days - a \$695 fee; between 99 - 70 days prior to departure - a \$775 fee; between 69 to departure date, 100% of the total cost of package. In addition, there will be a penalty applied for cancellation fees in case non-refundable airline ticket has been issued and single supplement fee if cancellation affects the accommodation of your roommate at the hotels. Only written cancellations will be considered. Name changes up to 100 days are acceptable for an \$90 administrative fee. From 99 days until day of departure, name changes will be considered as a cancellation. We highly recommend obtaining travel insurance to cover for cancellation fees due to medical reasons or acute financial situations. It also covers medical expenses overseas, accidents, lost or damaged luggage and more. Obtaining insurance with first deposit may waive pre-existing medical conditions. Please read all policy details in www.aviatours.net or ask for a brochure to be mailed to you. The time limit for insurance purchase is 60 days prior to the departure date but it will not cover pre-existing medical conditions.
